







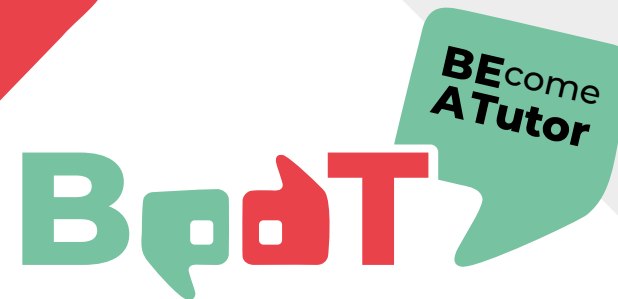
Project

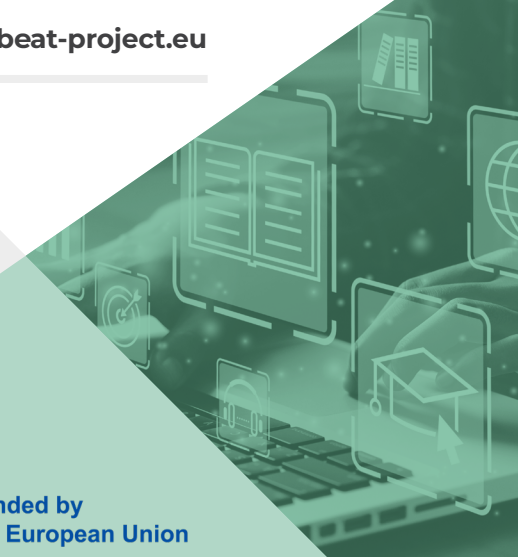
